The club was formed in 1994 by a small number of volunteers. It is a totally voluntary unpaid organisation and all donations received go directly to the children.



Presently there are 40 volunteers including doctors, nurses, paramedics, social workers, pharmacists, security officers, clerical workers from the Cork University Hospital, the Mercy Hospital, the Deaf Association and the Garda Síochána.

We fundraise to bring severely ill and deserving children to

Disneyland Paris. Children who have travelled with the Club include terminally ill children.

The club takes children with deafness, special needs, Down's Syndrome and children who have suffered physical and mental abuse. On occasion we take the siblings of these children too. We also bring children whose parents have passed away in tragic circumstances.



Since the club has started sadly over 90 children have gained their angel wings, but we are proud of the wonderful and happy memories we have helped create for their families.

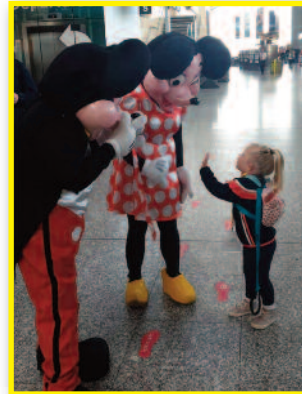
Disneyland Paris Trip



Every year since 1994 this club has brought sick and deserving children on a trip of a lifetime to Disneyland Paris.

Including volunteers approx. 75 people travel to Disneyland every year.

This trip is for children who face serious physical, mental and social challenges and is made possible by the significant fundraising efforts of our club.



Christmas Extravaganza

Every Christmas we create our very own Magical Winter Wonderland.

We bring around 240 children from all over Munster, who travel in convoy by vintage car with a Garda escort through Cork City.



The children have their own private sitting with Santa catering for their needs ie. the deaf children have their own deaf interpreter and usually for the first time can actually communicate with Santa Clause.

There are clowns, face painting, discos, party food and every child leaves with a framed photo and a present selected especially for them.
